FELONY COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Taney, State of Missouri, being duly sworn upon oath upon information and belief, and states that there is probable cause to believe that the accused committed the following crimes:

COUNT I

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Taney, State of Missouri, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 195.130, RSMo, committed the class C felony of maintaining a public nuisance, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011.1(3) and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about the 5th day of July,2006, in the County of Taney, State of Missouri, the defendant, BRADLEE D. MILLER maintained an inhabitable stucture, Whelchel Funeral Home, at 310 Commercial in Branson, and such structure was used for the illegal use, keeping or possession of controlled substance, to wit: methamphetamine, cocaine and marijuana.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached probable cause statement concerning this matter, which statement is made a part hereof and is submitted herewith as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause for the issuance of the criminal summons.
